Why make a KleckFiles Disk?

Besides being a pearl of great value? The UN recently announced that AI will be used to enforce “correct behaviour”. Already AI has removed dozens of my Jonathan Kleck videos from Google Drive. Clearly Christian truth material is no longer welcome on the Internet. Hence the need to make offline copies of Jonathan Kleck.

What Size Disk do I need?

A 2 TB Disk is required. There are 700 GB of videos. With Audio files and Show-Notes images it's about 900 GB total. Remember that Disk manufacturers call 1 TB = 1,000,000,000,000 bytes (which is only 900 GB of space in Windows and Mac – where 1 KB == 1,024 bytes not 1000 bytes).

Disk Choice?

Stick with name brands (WD, Samsung, Kingston, San-Disk). I have a modern fast compact USB 3.2 SSD - Kingston 2TB SX2000 (US\$150 on Amazon). Good for a fast reliable MASTER disk. Also buy a cheap 2TB WD Passport USB disks for Backup (US\$70 on Amazon). AI is shipping now with all new devices. And since the UN has announced that AI will be used to enforce “acceptable content” best to keep disks disconnected, and copy disks on a computer you never connect to the Internet (finally that old laptop has a use).

READ-ONLY Disks

Available in some countries some disks have a physical READ-ONLY switch. So protects against accidental or AI deletion of files. Research it.

Disk Formatting

New Disks come formatted as older style exFat or Fat32 which work on all platforms. But are slow, prone to corruption and losing files. Note that exFat format will add 200 GB to a KleckFiles disk (many small files aligning to cluster boundaries). But OK if making a disk for a member with a different computer platform to you.

Recommend:

Format your own MASTER and BACKUP disks using Native NTFS (for Windows) or APFS (for Apple Mac). These modern formats are more compact, robust, self healing and I believe faster.

Making Disks for Others

If you get the opportunity to copy your Master Disk for someone, you will need to negotiate: Which Disk Format? Paying for the disk? Cheap disk vs fast SSD (solid state)? Postal cost with insurance and signature?. Even if you can make a single copy, that copy could be copied to 1000s of people. Well worth the effort.

The KleckFiles Disks

It's one thing to give someone a disk full of loose MP4 video files, but the KleckFiles download effectively gives you www.KleckFiles.com site on a USB device. Any KleckFiles Media (videos/audio/show-notes) not found on the USB device is automatically streamed off the Internet.

Search, KJV+ Bible, Transcriptions, all the same as on the web site. No 3rd party software needed - Just a browser.

Browsers

All you need to run KleckFiles on a USB stick is a modern HTML5 web browser. FireFox, Opera, Brave, Safari etc. Google Chrome works but I found that while I handled Jonathan's Testimonies my PC was under regular attack. Once I removed Chrome the attacks mostly stopped.

Downloading / Updating your disk

On KleckFiles.com go to the Downloads page. Click through to the [Download Guide](#). This page will guide you to make / update a KleckFiles disk for local PC.

KleckFiles Site

The "Site", as well as the "Media" poster+thumb files are very small ZIPs to download. They contain all the web pages and images used by video lists. Windows users can alternatively use the "Setup.exe" download to install.

"Sites" are small and new "Sites" should be downloaded as soon as available. Unzip the "Site" to any location on your 2 TB disk (or use the Windows Setup.exe). Windows Setup.exe lets you choose a destination but also installs all post+thumb files under /KleckFiles.media/video/poster/ and /KleckFiles.media/video/thumb/.

KleckFiles Media

You can have many "Sites" anywhere on the disk but only one "Media" folder. The active "Site" you run expects to find "Media" under a root folder called "/KleckFiles.media/" on the same 2TB disk. There are 4 main "Media" buckets (folders).

- /KleckFiles.media/video/
- /KleckFiles.media/video_mp3/ (audio)
- /KleckFiles.media/shownotes/
- /KleckFiles.media/radio/ (BlogTalkRadio .mp3 shows)

On the download servers you will see these folders and the expected directory structure.

Download to the expected folders using the expected file names and they should appear in your KleckFiles "Site" (no Internet required to run).

Show-Notes

Show notes Gallery 1 & 2 are made up of 300,000 images (thumbs, mid-size, large). On the download server these are found in 3GB ZIP files. You need to download the ZIPs and drag their content (unzip) to the correct location.

At the time of writing Gallery 2 is still growing. New image ZIPs are added when new "Sites" are uploaded.

Videos MP4 and MP3 Files

Videos (.MP4 files) and Audio versions of the videos (.MP3 audio files) are available as single files (not zipped) on the servers. Google Drive and Koofr, when you select more than one file for download, will package the selected files into 2 or 3 GB ZIP files for download. If you want you can research raising the download limits up to 50 GB file size.

Note that Google AI is actively deleting files the NWO don't like so expect to find holes in the collection you download. At the moment Google Drive is the only problem but that will probably change. The new system will be enforced across the world.

Virtual Connections to Download Servers

When downloading so many files I found it easier to setup a virtual drive to the server on your PC then copy the folders and files across using the usual copy and paste.

- Although these are public KleckFiles shares, sometimes it's easier to copy the collection over to your own Drive or Koofr account. You will need to purchase 2TB space (for a month or more as needed).
- For Google Drive - download the free Google "Drive for Desktop" (Windows and Apple versions). See the tutorial videos on the guide page.
- For Koofr they have an equivalent (I think it's called : Local folders). It works and allowed me to mirror the server files and folders.
- To transfer the files you probably need to send the owner (me, Robert) a request and I add you to the subscriber/share list.
